THE ARREST OF JESUS

Luke 22:1-6, 39-65 Luke 23:1-25

Thursday, 6 April 2023

Good Friday started with the dramatic events in Gethsemane where Jesus was betrayed, arrested and tried before Pilate, the Roman Governor, and the religious leaders. The disciples of Jesus fled the scene except for Peter who later denied Him. Maybe they were too fearful or not ready to face the same fate as their Master Jesus. In other words, they had not fully grasped of the purpose and significance of His suffering even though Jesus had prepared them for it.

We face many challenges, pressures, persecution, betrayal and false accusations in our Christian walk. God has never promised us a smooth path but He has assured us of His faithfulness and presence.

Reflections

- 2. When things do not go well, would you doubt and deny Jesus and walk out of your faith and calling? If yes, what can you do to strengthen your faith? If no, how can you sustain yourself against the onslaught?

THE CRUCIFIXION OF JESUS

Luke 23:26-56

Friday, 7 April 2023

Jesus was willing to suffer and die by crucifixion as the ultimate sacrifice for our sins. Crucifixion was one of the most brutal death penalties ever recorded in

At the crucifixion site, there were different groups of people – the religious leaders, the soldiers, the two robbers, the many women, the passers-by, the multitudes and one of the disciples. There was no mention of the presence of other disciples there, who were the closest to Him.

We will never know what was passing through the minds of each group of people. Some were probably saddened and lost, some were rejoicing and in a celebrative mood, some were not even affected by what was happening, and the list goes on. It was indeed a mixed multitude there.
