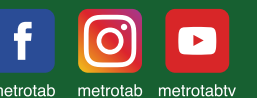

This is a powerful story to help people understand the love of the Father, and I look forward to hearts being touched and healed."



Sean Lim plays *Jacob*, a young man who longs for a "better life" and is adamant that he can only find what he is seeking for in the glare of the bright city lights. When he comes across a *"once in a lifetime"* opportunity to do so, he impulsively leaves everything behind. Along the way, he discovers that not everything that glitters is gold, and that spurning his father's love was his biggest regret.
